Dear Parent/Guardian of AP Students,

Lanier High School students will register for Advanced Placement (AP) exams online through your student's **MyPaymentsPlus** account. Exam registration and payment is currently open and will continue through March 16, 2018.

If you currently have a **MyPaymentsPlus** account (for school lunches, last year's AP exams, etc.), simply go to your student account, select "Make a Fees & Activities Payment", and register for the exams your student wishes to take. If you are new to **MyPaymentsPlus**, it is very easy to create an account. The website is user friendly and easy to manipulate. Go to: <http://www.mypaymentsplus.com>.

MyPaymentsPlus accepts credit cards, debit cards, and e-checks. It is a highly secure site. This year, paying for exams with cash is not an option. In order to guarantee exam registration, students must use **MyPaymentsPlus**.

STUDENT REGISTRATION

- All students pay a \$10.00 non-refundable registration fee.

GCPS students enrolled in AP Courses:

- GCPS will pay for 1 exam.
- Each additional exam is \$94.00.

GCPS students who are Free/Reduced Lunch students and enrolled in AP Courses:

- GCPS will pay for all exams.

Student NOT enrolled in a GCPS AP Course- \$94.00 per exam

NOTE: There is a **\$15.00** return fee per exam for any registered exam that a student does not take.

*Please note that once your student has registered and paid for an exam, any refund must be handled by contacting Mrs. Burrell as refunds cannot be processed online. Refunds may only be granted prior to the close of registration.

Students will be taking AP exams May 7th-18th. Please see your student's AP Bulletin or visit the College Board website for specific test dates: <http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/about.html>.

- All registration will be done online at www.mypaymentsplus.com (credit cards, debit cards, or e-checks).
- If a student does not currently have an account at MyPaymentsPlus, he/she must set one up before registering.
- If your student notices that he or she has **two AP exams scheduled for the same time**, you must see Mrs. Burrell in order to sign up for late testing without an additional fee.
- Any student needing LATE AP TESTING for the following reasons must pay **an additional \$45** per exam (and must contact Mrs. Burrell):
 - Academic contest or event
 - Athletic contest or event
 - Conflict with non-AP and non-IB exam
 - Family commitment
 - Other school event
- Student's attendance will be excused (marked as ACT) for the entire day on the day of their exam. They will report directly to the testing room on exam day.
